Senior Faculty Transition Program (SFTP) and Effort Reporting

The effort report should reflect all activities conducted under the terms of your employment by JHU. Effort is expressed as a percentage of total employed time and is not reflected in hours. The total effort expended cannot be more than - or less than - 100%.

Once an award is accepted, the University is committed to providing level of effort expressed in the Notice of Award. Decrease in the level of committed effort of 25% or greater for federal awards must be authorized by the sponsor. For example 20% of a full time faculty member working 40 hours a week is 8 hours per week. If the effort on the federal award decreases to 6 hours or less per week the decrease in committed effort must be authorized by the sponsor. Sponsor approval may be required for decreases to committed effort at a minimum of 10% for contracts. Please consult agency guidelines for further direction.

Year 1 -75% of FTE

The Full Time salary is \$180,000 X 75% = \$135,000

Semi Annually (Effort Reporting) \$135,000/2 = \$67,500

During Year 1 of the Phase Retirement Program, Sally Harrison provided effort to following projects:

40% (12 hours/week) on NIH Award #2 (67,500 X 40% = \$27,000)

20% (6 hours/week) on Robert Wood Johnson (67,500 X 20% = \$13,500)

40% (12 hours/week) on Departmental and University Administration (67,500 X 40% = \$27,000)

Total Effort is 100% (30 hours/week)
