

IF7-SN38 Cancer Trial in Dogs

To assess the effectiveness of a novel chemotherapeutic in dogs with cancer.

Baseline screening performed at your veterinarian is required for entrance into the study.

Inclusion Criteria

- Dog is a minimum of nine months of age;
- Dog has no major concurrent health issue;
- Dog is eligible to begin chemotherapy immediately;
- Dog has been diagnosed with cancer and the largest tumor < 3cm;
- Dogs with metastatic disease and/or resistant to standard of care therapy will be considered;
- Pet owner is willing and able to sign a consent form and comply with all study procedures for the duration of the study

Exclusion Criteria

- Anticipated life expectancy < 3 weeks;
- Single or double positive for MDR1 genetic mutation;
- Evidence of serious systemic disorder;
- Any condition that may preclude the evaluation of safety and/or activity of the study drug;
- Other concurrent cancer treatment, investigational drug or intervention
