This memorandum summarizes the parking and transportation arrangements available to Third and Fourth Year Medical Students. Street parking adjacent to the Johns Hopkins Medical Institutions is unsafe, and students are strongly encouraged to use the parking options described in this memo. Please use the free scheduled Johns Hopkins Medical Institutions van service or the Shuttle Services provided by the transportation department. 1) Parking - Garage parking provided for all 3rd and 4th year students

Garage Parking - Johns Hopkins Medical Institutions

ID badges for members of the 3rd and 4th year classes have been activated to permit access to either the Ashland garage, Caroline St. garage, or McElderry St. garage.

Parking utilization will be closely monitored. Parking privileges will be revoked for anyone who allows non-authorized use of an I.D. badge for parking.

Parking - The Johns Hopkins Bayview Medical Center

Parking will be provided to students on rotation to Johns Hopkins Bayview Medical Center. The required clerkship administrators will have you complete a dual access parking form at the time assignment is made to JHBMC. While on the Bayview campus the JHBMC parking office will either assign you to the Northeast lot or the Staff lot, dependent upon availability.

FREE Garage Parking (all garages EXCEPT Ashland Garage and) - After 4:00 p.m. - Johns Hopkins Medical Institutions

Evening, nighttime (after 4:00 pm and before 8:30 am) and weekend parking is available to all students without cost. Students need to register for BASE ACCESS at the Parking Office (Nelson/Harvey Room 108) to be able to use this free access period. Scan I.D. badge to gain access and to leave the garage.

Orleans St. - 24 hours/day, 7 days/week

Washington St. - 6 am - 12 midnight, Mon. - Fri.; 7 am - 7 pm, Saturday and Sunday

Rutland Ave. - 24 hours/day, 7 days/week McElderry St. - 24 hours/day, 7 days/week

Caroline St. - 5:30 am Monday - 9:00 am Saturday, Closed Saturday and Sunday

2) JH Safe Ride-New Service available to students effective August 1, 2018

Free transportation service thru Lyft for students who live within a 1.5 mile radius of the East Baltimore Campus.

5) Mass Transit Administration (MTA)

MTA passes are available at \$30/month through the School of Medicine Office of Financial Affairs. Passes cannot be purchased during the months that other subsidized parking is utilized.
